The staff training and professional learning provided by the Ministry of Education this Tuesday proved to be most worthwhile. Our learning was focused on positive student management and behaviour of all our students here at Newtown.

This term was brought to prominence in the educational sphere by Angela Duckworth. Her research around 'grit,' defined as 'perseverance and passion for long-term goals' shows the positive impact of grit on student achievement. 
