Teachers Strike

You will have heard in the media about teachers striking next Thursday 16th March.

Members have voted to strike because the funding for our schools is not sufficient to give teachers and principals the time and resources to teach. More resourcing is needed to ensure that:

- all of our tamariki thrive, and
- we can retain our quality educators and school leaders in the sector.

On Thursday, teachers and principals across Aotearoa will be taking joint action to highlight these issues.

The Board has carefully considered the availability of non-union teaching staff, and unfortunately decided that we can't provide normal instruction during the strike so the **school** will officially be closed for instruction on Thursday 16th March.


Newtown Open Studios
